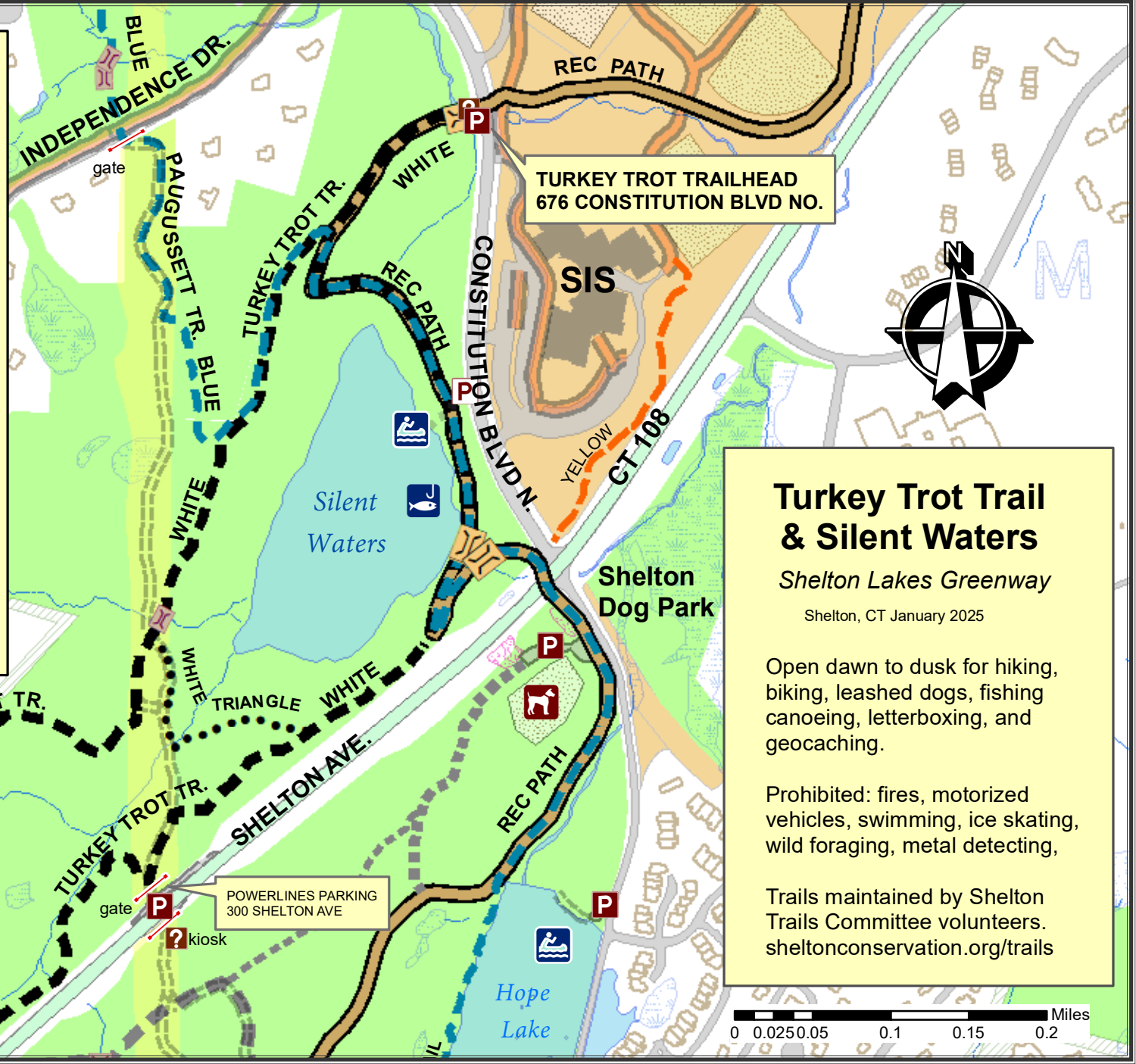


Turkey Trot Trail (white blazes) provides a 2.1-mile "lollipop loop" hike if starting at the trailhead on Constitution Blvd North.

The Shelton Lakes Recreation Path (4.1 mi.) is handicapped-accessible and connects downtown Shelton with Huntington Center.

The Paugussett Trail (blue blazes) is a 13-mile regional hiking trail established in the 1930s that begins on Buddington Road and ends in Monroe. From Independence Drive, the trail continues north to Wiacek Meadows, Housatonic Woods, Indian Well, and Birchbank Mountain.

All three trails share the same pathway across the top of the Silent Waters dam. Watch for trail markings where the paths diverge.
